The DC Courts have **remote sites** available in various locations in the community to help persons who may not have computer devices or internet service at home. The Courts are committed to enhancing access to justice for all.

There are five remote access sites throughout the community which will operate:
Monday – Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

If you want to use a remote site location, call **202-879-1900** or email DCCourtsRemoteSites@dcsc.gov **at least 24 hours before to reserve a remote access computer station.** Also paper copies of the CVCP application are available at each location.

You should bring the following items when you come to your scheduled site location

1. Any documents you need to submit with your CVCP application (including exhibits, receipts, photos, contracts, etc.)
2. At these locations, CVCP claimants can pick-up and drop off CVCP applications.
