The D.C. Court of Appeals currently records oral arguments using a digital system, permitting copies to be made to CDs. Persons interested in obtaining a recording of an oral argument may do so by submitting the following:

- 1) A written request for a copy of the argument, identifying the case name, case number, the date of argument, and type of playback system (i.e., "PC or MAC").
- 2) A postage-paid, self-addressed envelope of sufficient size to hold a CD, with at least 83 cents postage on it. If the CD will be picked up, please state so in the request and include the name of the person, their phone number and/or their email address. Remember you **must** specify whether the recordings will be played back on a PC or MAC system when submitting your request. **Note:** "PC format will play on compact disk players." **Also, it is not necessary to submit a blank CD**
