SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 04-12

(Suspends Admin. Order 04-10)

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 04-10 established access to certain agencies to juvenile records without restriction; and

WHEREAS, with the exception of stay away orders issued against juvenile respondents, certain restrictions on the access of different agencies to some juvenile records appear prudent and necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby

ORDERED, that only for the purpose of and to the extent necessary to enforce them, stay away orders issued against and custody orders for juvenile respondents may shared among authorized personnel of the Metropolitan Police Department, the Office of the Attorney General for the District of Columbia and the Office of the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia; and it is further

ORDERED, that in all other respects, Administrative Order No. 04-10 be and is hereby suspended and of no effect until further order of the Court.
