SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 04-16

(Changes in Courtroom Use)

WHEREAS, With the opening of the new courtrooms on the JM level of the Moultrie Building a number of courtrooms have been reassigned; and

WHEREAS, there remains a shortage of courtrooms with cell blocks, and a number of courtrooms do not have jury rooms; and

WHEREAS, to fairly allocate courtrooms among the competing demands for their use it is essential that occupancy of courtrooms be predictable and comprehensible by the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY,

ORDERED, effective immediately, judicial officers should remain in their assigned courtrooms; and it is further,

ORDERED, any judicial officer wishing to use a courtroom other than his or her regularly assigned courtroom, if any, for any purpose and any judicial officer who will not need his or her assigned courtroom for one-half of a day or more should contact the Office of the Clerk of the Court and arrange any change in courtroom availability or use through that office; and it is further,

ORDERED, arrangements made through the Office of the Clerk of the Court shall take precedence over any changes in courtroom use not so arranged.
