O R D E R (FILED - April 27, 2011)

It appearing that the results of the February, 2011, District of Columbia Bar Examination ("bar examination") will not be released until a few days before the initial deadline to apply to take the July, 2011, bar examination; and it further appearing that those persons who were unsuccessful in the February, 2011, bar examination will have only two or three business days before the initial deadline of May 3, 2011, to apply to take the July, 2011, bar examination, and that failure to apply by May 3, 2011, will result in an additional \$200 late application filing fee for those applicants who wish to take the July, 2011, bar examination; and it further appearing that the interests of justice warrant a waiver of the \$200 late application filing fee for those applicants who were unsuccessful in the February, 2011, bar examination, and who wish to apply to take the July, 2011, bar examination, it is

ORDERED that D.C. App. R. 46 (b)(2)(iii) is hereby waived with respect to persons who were unsuccessful in the February, 2011, bar examination insofar as that rule requires the payment of a \$200 late application filing fee for persons who apply to take the July, 2011, Bar examination after May 3, 2011, and before the final deadline to apply, which occurs 15 days after May 3, 2011.
