

ORDER (FILED – May 15, 2018)

It appearing that, for purposes of American Bar Association reporting, law schools have need of information from this court's Committee on Admissions ("Committee") regarding bar examination passage or failure of applicants who are graduates of their law schools, and that D.C. App. R. 46 would benefit from greater clarity with respect to whether the Committee may disclose applicant bar exam result information to law schools, it is

ORDERED that, upon request of the Dean of any law school, the Committee is authorized to disclose to the law school the names of each of its graduating students who sat for the District of Columbia Bar Examination and whether each student passed or failed the exam.
