

O R D E R (FILED – July 16, 2018)

WHEREAS, this court's Administrative Order 3-18 issued April 25, 2018, detailed new procedures for successful applicants seeking admission to the District of Columbia Bar, including limiting formal swearing-in ceremonies to July and December, and it appearing that, due to the significant increase in the number of exam takers, the December swearing-in ceremonies may not, at present, be practical because of the need to extend the time to grade the July bar exam and before announcing results, it is

ORDERED that, in lieu of July and December, Bar swearing-in ceremonies shall be held in July and January. Other admissions procedures as stated in Administrative Order 3-18 are unchanged.
