He was appointed by **President Obama** and was confirmed by the Senate in November. He began his career with the U.S. Marshals Service in 1991, serving in several positions including time with the Witness Security Division and protection detail for the Deputy Attorney General and also Sen. **Frank Lautenberg** (D-N.J.). He previously worked as the Chief of the Office of Crisis Services within the U.S. Marshal Service's Tactical Operations Division.

Hughes graduated from Montclair State University in 1990 and received a Master of Public Administration degree from American University in 2007.
