

# Chief Justice Roberts not picked for jury duty

ROCKVILLE, Md. (WUSA9) -- Chief Justice John Roberts was not chosen after he showed up for jury duty Wednesday in Rockville, Md., reported our editorial partners at [\*The Washington Post\*](#).

Justice Roberts left without speaking.

This is not the first time a Supreme Court Justice has not been chosen for jury duty.

In 2005, Justice Stephen Breyer reported for jury duty in Marlborough, Mass. and was barely recognized.

In 2011 and 2014, Justice Elena Kagan showed up for jury duty at least twice in District of Columbia Superior Court, but didn't make the cut.
