Children's Law Center (CLC) fights so every child in D.C. can grow up with a stable family, good health, and a quality education by providing free legal services and advocating for citywide changes.

CLC provides free civil legal services to families living on low incomes in the following areas:

Family: We provide free, high-quality legal assistance to grandparents, relatives, and other third-party caregivers seeking custody, guardianship, or adoption of children in their care.

Health: We provide free, high-quality legal assistance to families seeking repairs to unhealthy housing conditions. We work with families served by Children's National Health System, Mary's Center, and Unity Health Care.

Education: We provide free, high-quality legal assistance to parents and caregivers of children with disabilities who need educational services and supports to benefit from their education. We work with families served by Children's National Health System, Mary's Center, and Unity Health Care.
