DC COURTS ANNOUNCE LAUNCH OF www.DCCourtsNews.gov

WASHINGTON DC — The District of Columbia Courts are proud to announce another addition to their online presence: a new website with news stories relating to court services, ceremonies, events and initiatives. The launch of DCCourtsNews.gov (www.dccourtsnews.gov) is part of the Courts' effort to actively reach out to the public to enhance public understanding of the judicial branch.

DCCourtsNews.gov will be in an e-zine format, with news stories posted regularly, with links to photos and additional information on the Courts' main website. DCCourtsNews.gov features an RSS feed, a listing of recent 'tweets' posted by the DC Courts (for those who are not on Twitter), as well as a subscription option to receive a bi-monthly email newsletter with stories from DCCourtsNews.gov.
