**SECOND ORDER FOR ALTERNATIVE SERVICE BY POSTING ON THE
PUTATIVE FATHER AND LEGAL FATHER**

This matter is before the Court upon consideration of Plaintiff Sendy Stefanie Sasco Sanchez (“Plaintiff”) Motion for Alternative Service by Posting on Defendant Miguel Julian¹ (“Defendant Putative Father”) and Defendant Wayner Martinez Perdomo² (“Defendant Legal Father”) filed on April 3, 2024. The instant case involves a Complaint for Custody for one Minor Child. Plaintiff has filed a motion providing the details of her diligent search for both the Minor Child’s putative father and legal father, whose whereabouts are unknown.

On April 5, 2024, the Court issued an order granting the Plaintiff’s motion and ordered that the Plaintiff may serve the Defendants by posting on the Superior Court for the District of Columbia’s website for a period of twenty-one (21) calendar days and in the Domestic Relations Clerk’s Office, starting with the date of the order. The matter was scheduled for May 21, 2024, at 11:00 a.m.

¹ Plaintiff in her Complaint for Custody states that she believes Defendant Miguel Julian is the biological father, although no genetic testing has been completed and he is not listed on the Minor Child’s birth certificate.

² Defendant Wayner Martinez Perdomo is listed as the Minor Child’s father on his birth certificate and therefore, is her legal father.

On April 30, 2024, the Domestic Relations Clerk's Office informed chambers that the order for posting that the Court issued on April 5, 2024, was inadvertently not posted on the display board in the Domestic Relations Clerk's Office and only posted on the Courts' Website for the specified 21 days. Due to this insufficient service of process, the Court determined that a hearing must be rescheduled to provide sufficient time for the Defendants to be properly served by posting. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the hearing on the Plaintiff's Complaint for Custody and Motion for Special Immigrant Juvenile Status that is rescheduled for **Tuesday, June 18, 2024, at 2:00 p.m.** before Magistrate Judge Julie R. Breslow on WebEx 99 (instructions on how to appear remotely are attached to this order); and the hearing that was scheduled for May 21, 2024 is **VACATED**; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff may serve Defendant Miguel Julian, the putative father of the Minor Child, D.A.M.S. (D.O.B. 6/22/2006) by posting on the Superior Court for the District of Columbia's website for a period of twenty-one (21) calendar days and in the Domestic Relations Clerk's Office, starting with the date of this order; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff may serve Defendant Wayner Martinez Perdomo, the legal father of the Minor Child, D.A.M.S. (D.O.B. 6/22/2006) by posting on the Superior Court for the District of Columbia's website for a period of twenty-one (21) calendar days and in the Domestic Relations Clerk's Office, starting with the date of this order; and it is


FURTHER ORDERED that if Defendant Miguel Julian and/or Defendant Wayner Martinez Perdomo does not file a responsive pleading within twenty-one (21) days after service pursuant to the Rules Governing Domestic Relations Proceedings, Rule 12(a), Plaintiff may file a motion for default and the Court may enter default by order and may convert the next hearing

into a default/*ex parte* hearing to take testimony from Plaintiff and file a final judgment without Defendant Miguel Julian's and/or Defendant Wayner Martinez Perdomo's participation, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that if Plaintiff is seeking a default judgment, prior to the next scheduling hearing, Plaintiff shall file an Affidavit in Compliance with the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act; and it is

SO ORDERED.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS COMPLAINT, you must file a written objection with the Court within twenty-one (21) days, and appear for the hearing scheduled for **June 18, 2024, at 2:00 p.m. on Webex 99 or in-person in Courtroom HR-99 of the Moultrie Courthouse, 500 Indiana Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. 20001**, that will be held remotely due to the coronavirus pandemic. Instructions to appear remotely are stated below and can be obtained in writing by contacting the chambers of Judge Breslow at MagistrateJudgeBreslowChambers@dcsc.gov in advance of the hearing. If you do not file a written objection within twenty-one (21) days or appear at the hearing, default may be entered against you, the hearing may be converted to a default/*ex parte* proof hearing and judgment may be entered without further proceedings. Your objection should be emailed to FamilyCourtCIC@dcsc.gov, and directed to the Domestic Relations Branch Clerk, Family Court, Superior Court of the District of Columbia, 500 Indiana Avenue NW, Washington, D.C. 20001.

IF YOU DO NOT WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS COMPLAINT, you may consent to the relief sought prior to the hearing scheduled for **June 18, 2024, at 2:00 p.m. on Webex 99 or in-person in Courtroom HR-99 of the Moultrie Courthouse, 500 Indiana Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. 20001**.
