

**SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA  
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 11-05**

**Re-establishment of the CJA/CCAN Investigator Panel**

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order 10-14, issued on September 28, 2010, required the reconstitution of the Criminal Justice Act Panel (“CJA Panel”) of investigators and directed the Defender Services Branch in the D.C. Courts Budget and Finance Office to receive, and the Investigator Advisory Committee to evaluate applications; and

**WHEREAS**, the Investigator Advisory Committee submitted its memorandum on its procedures for evaluating applications and recommended names of investigators to be appointed to the CJA/CCAN Investigator Panel; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful study and consideration of each person eligible to be considered, the Chief Judge is satisfied with the recommendations of the Investigator Advisory Committee, with respect to the individuals to be placed on the CJA/CCAN Investigator Panel; and

**WHEREAS**, the Investigator Advisory Committee also submitted the names of twenty-seven (27) individuals who applied to renew their status as investigators by the December 1, 2010 deadline, but whose updated FBI background clearances were not submitted by the March 31, 2011 deadline; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the administration of justice for the CJA/CCAN Investigator Panel to be re-established at this time;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is by the Court,

**ORDERED**, that the individuals listed in Attachment A are designated members of the CJA/CCAN Investigator Panel effective immediately; it is further

**ORDERED**, that the individuals listed in Attachment B are designated provisional members of the CJA/CCAN Investigator Panel for the purpose of completing any outstanding cases; it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Investigator Advisory Committee may submit the names of the provisional members for consideration to become full panel members upon receipt of their updated FBI background clearances; it is further

**ORDERED**, that absent suspension or removal, and except as otherwise stated hereafter, the investigators listed are appointed to the CJA/CCAN Investigator Panel for a period of four (4) years, at which time they must submit an application for reappointment; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that an investigator's membership on the Panel is conditioned upon his or her compliance with all Administrative Orders relating to investigators under the CJA Plan.
