## 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Adoption Day in Court Celebrates a Family for Every Child while Promoting Children's Literacy

DC Superior Court and the DC Child and Family Services Agency will co-host their 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Adoption Day in Court ceremony on Saturday, November 17, 2012. The ceremony is designed to celebrate the joy of adoption and encourage area residents to consider adopting or fostering a child in the District's public child welfare system. Approximately **120** children in DC foster care are awaiting adoptive homes.

Over 20 adoptions will be finalized at this year's ceremony. Each child and his or her family will be introduced to the audience to come forward as their judge signs the adoption decree.
