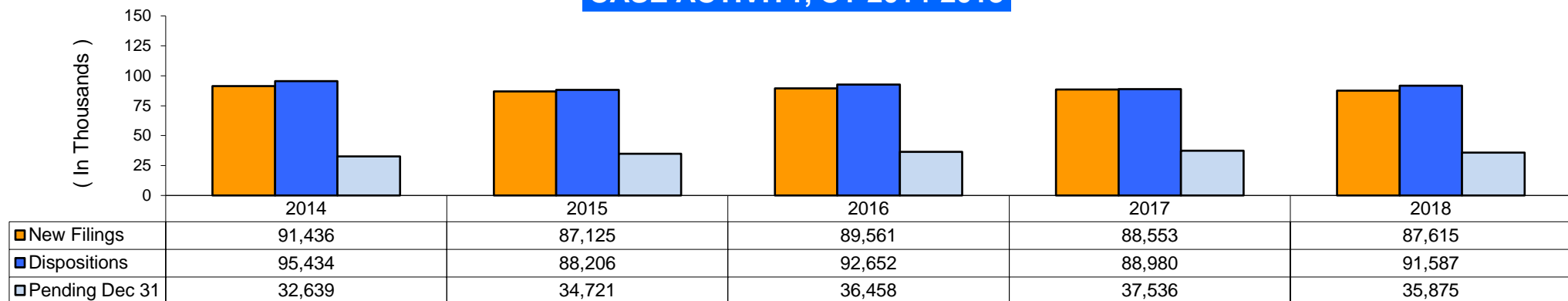

## CASE ACTIVITY, CY 2014-2018

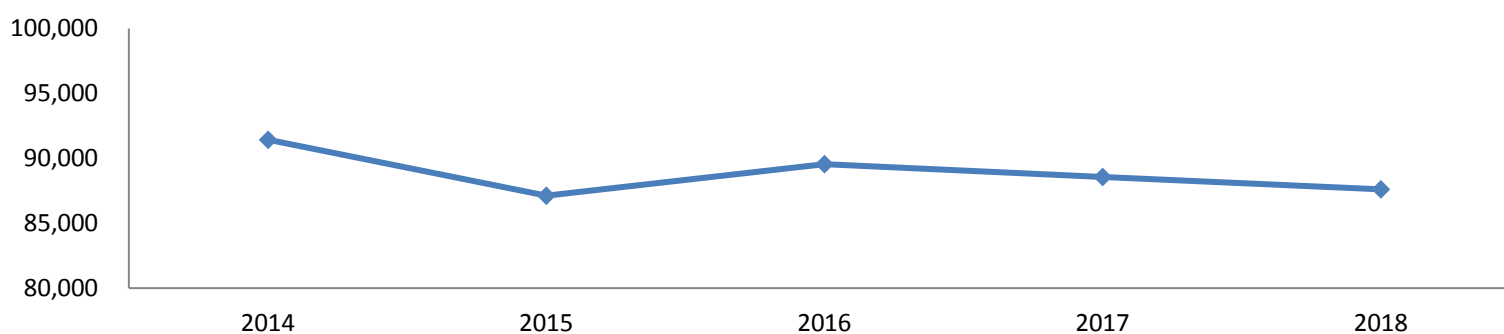

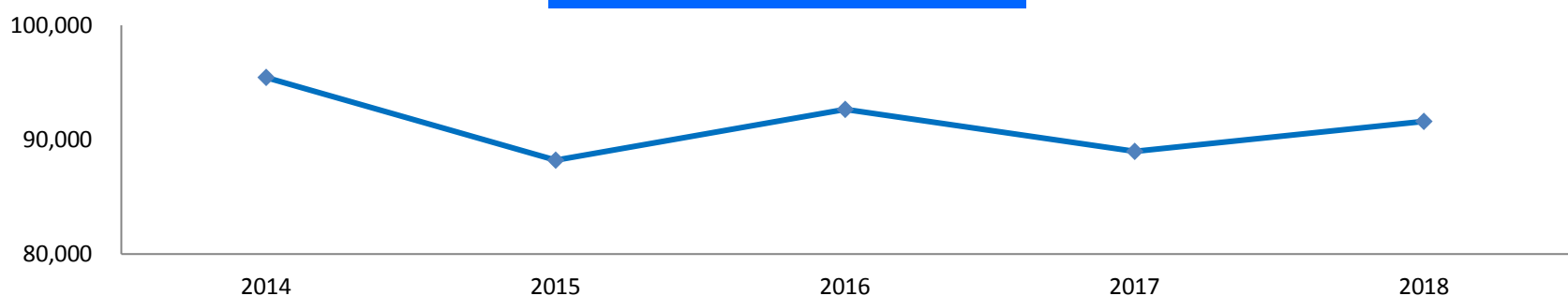

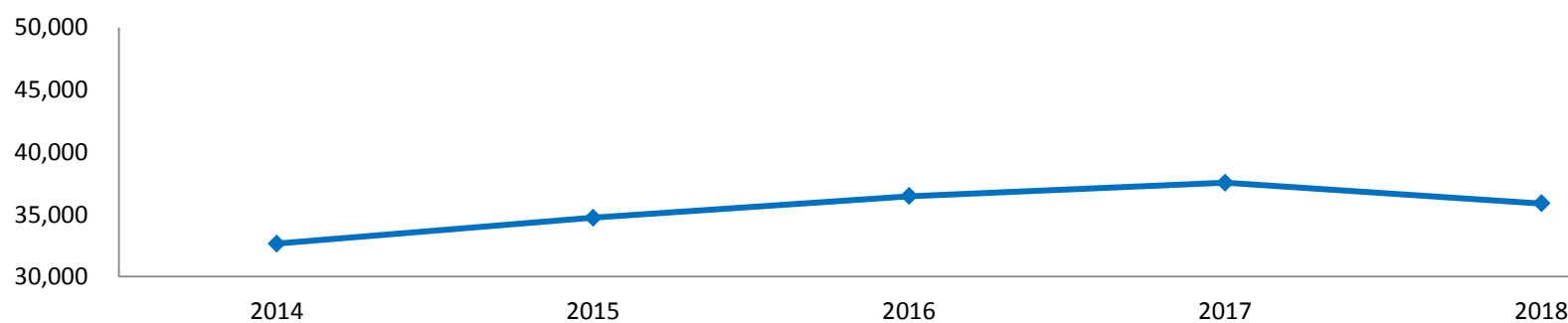

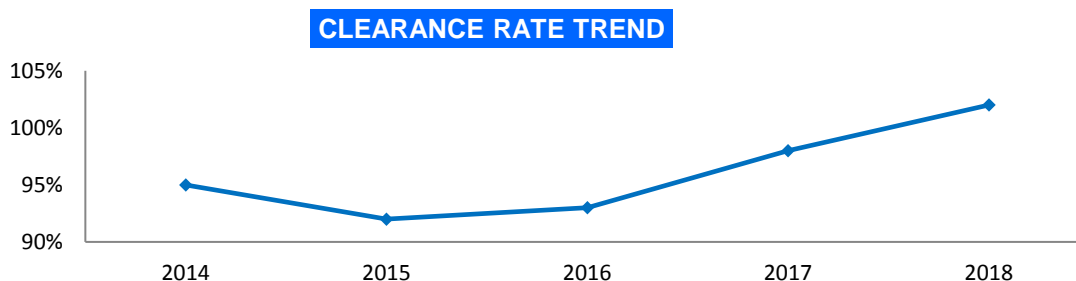

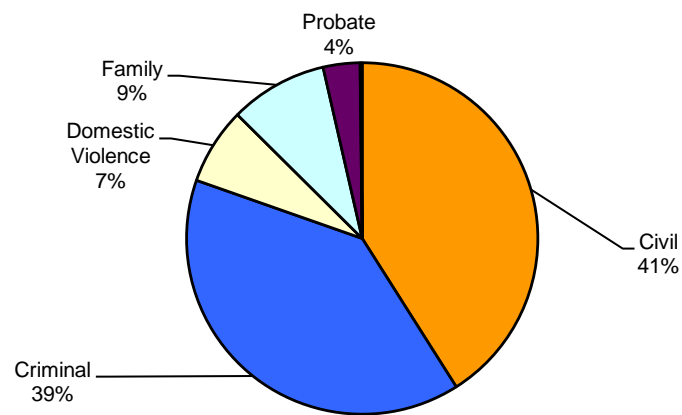

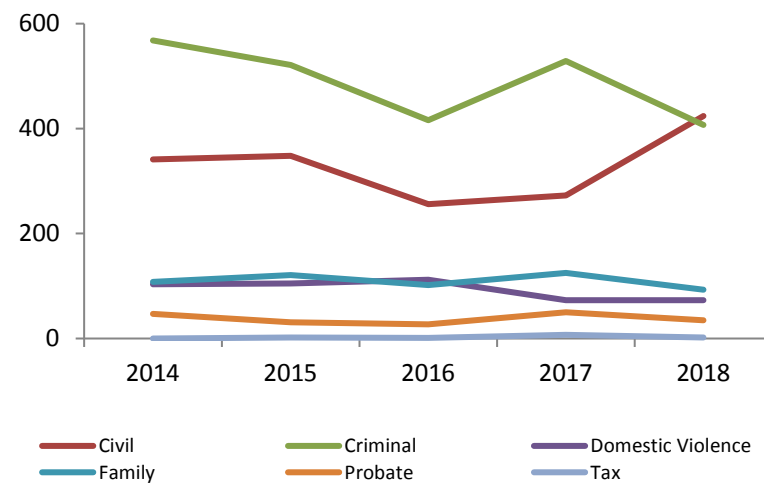

Trend in Appeals, CY2014-2018

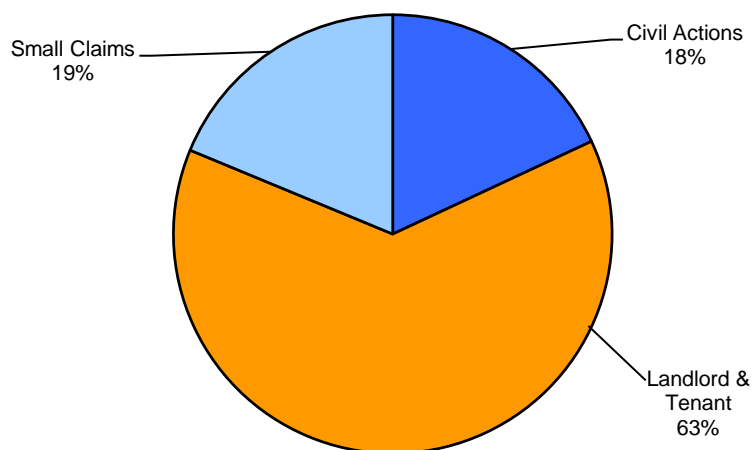

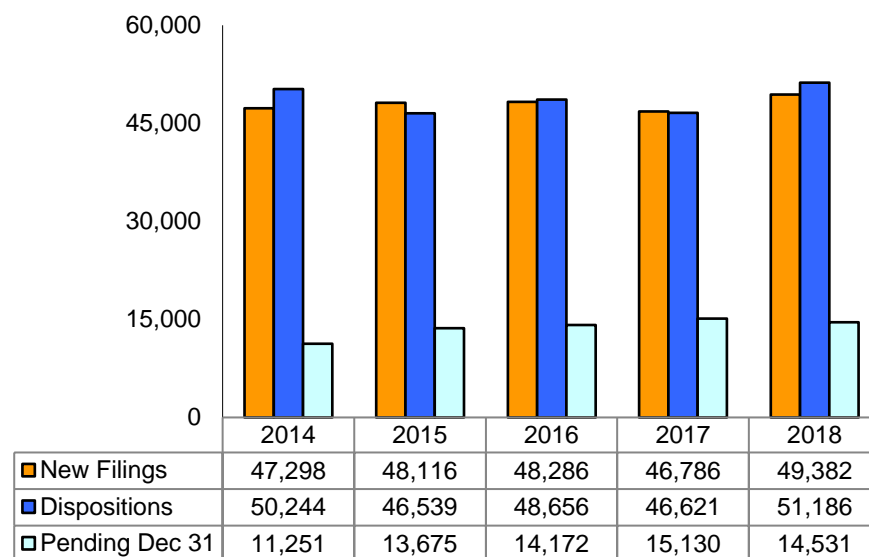

2018 New Case Filings (N=49,382)



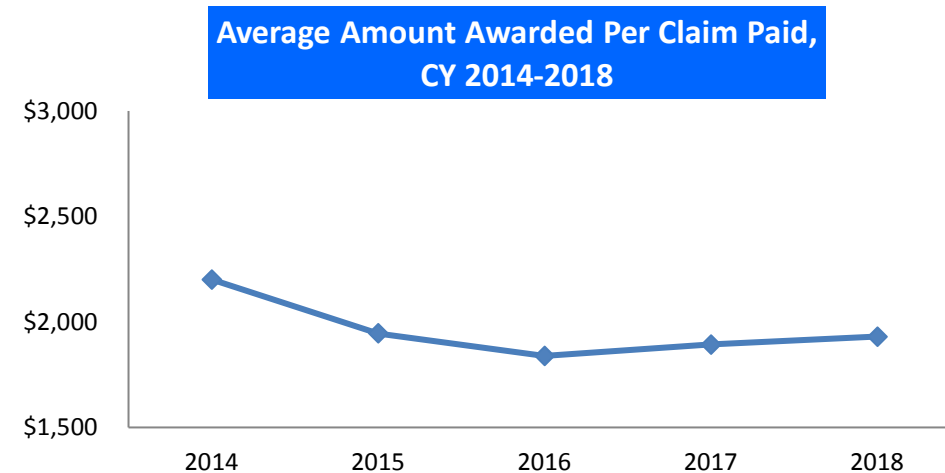
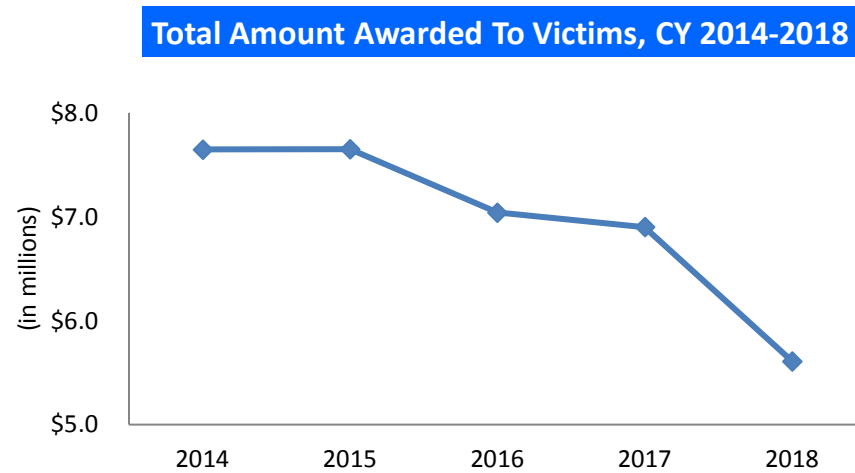
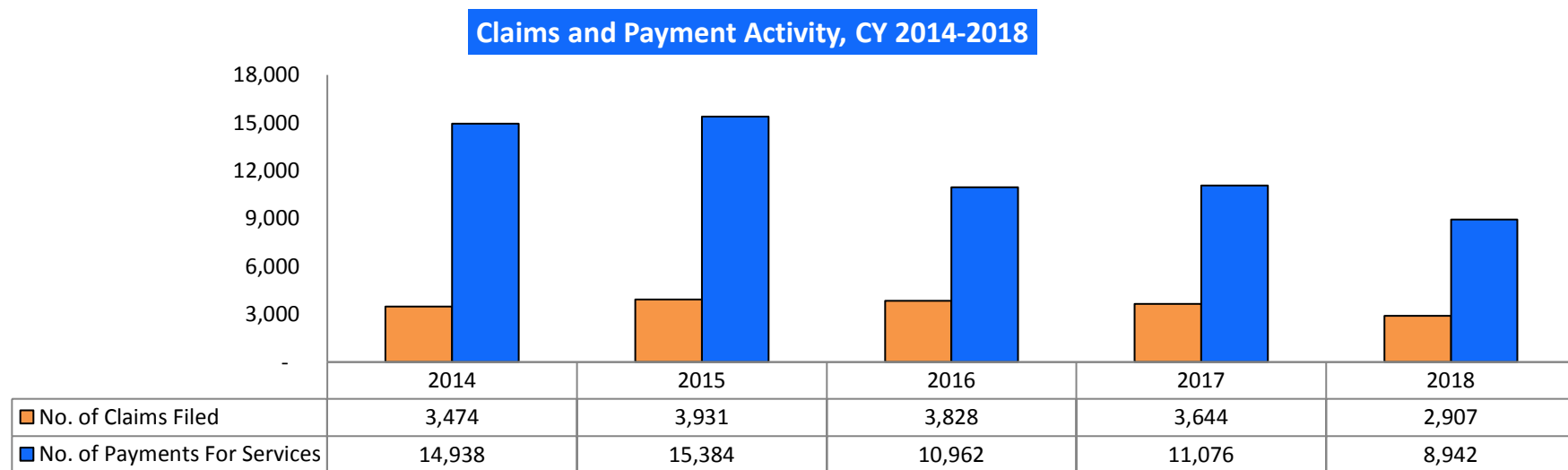

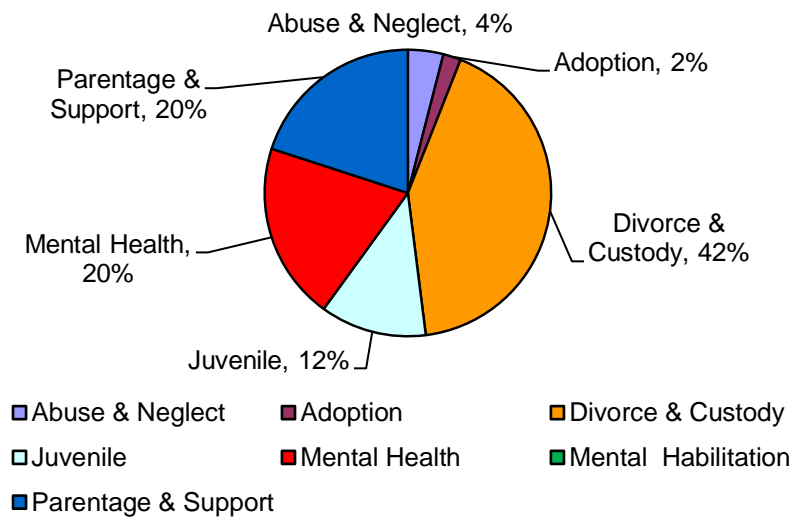

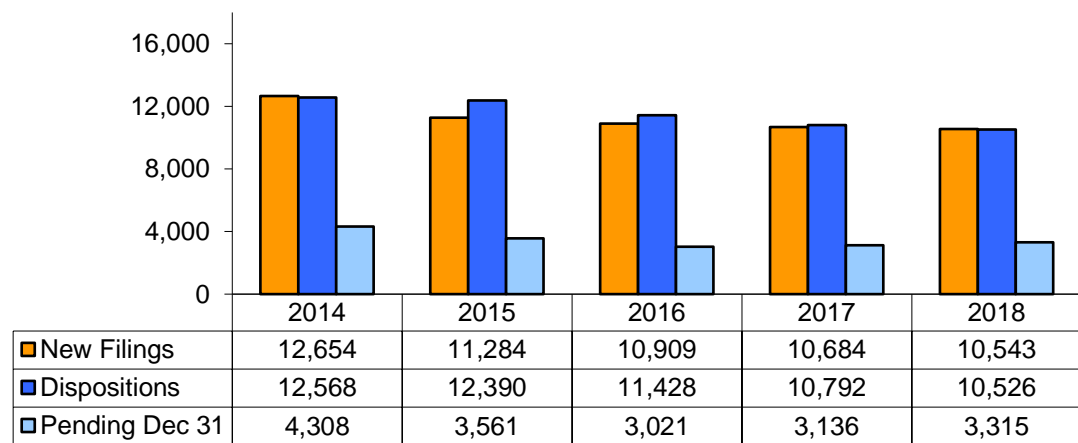

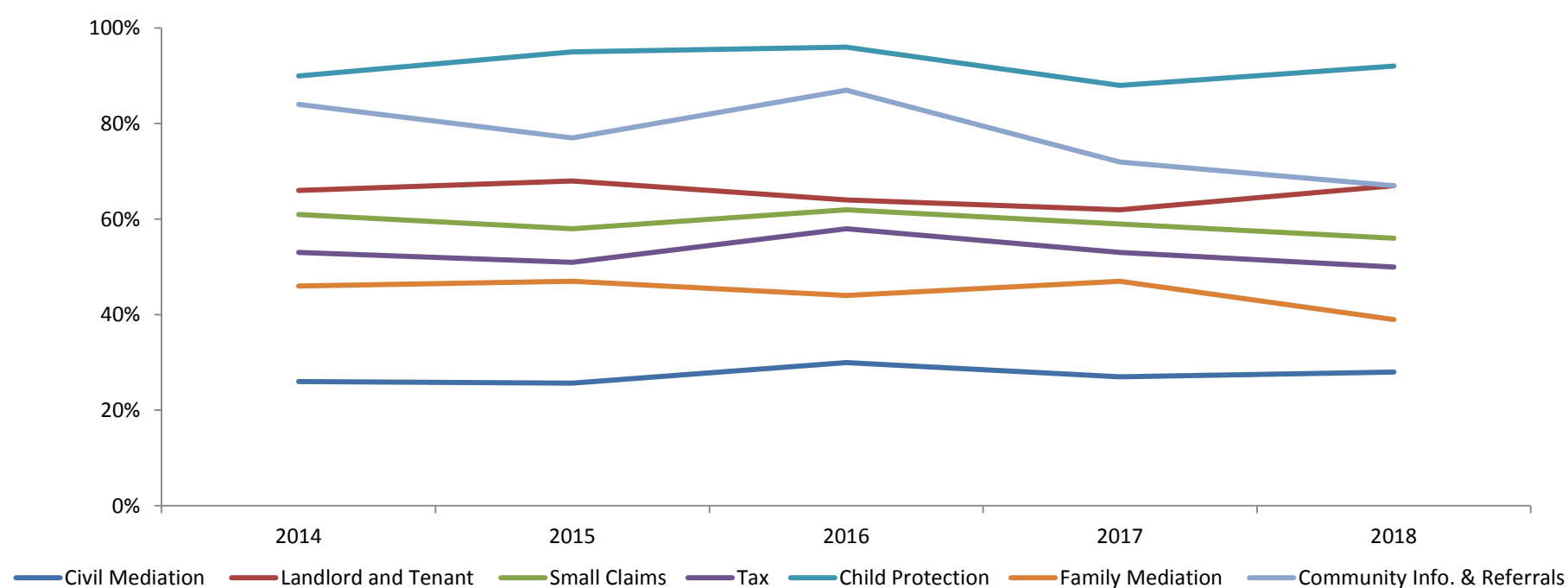

### Settlement Rate of Select Mediation Case Type, CY 2014-2018



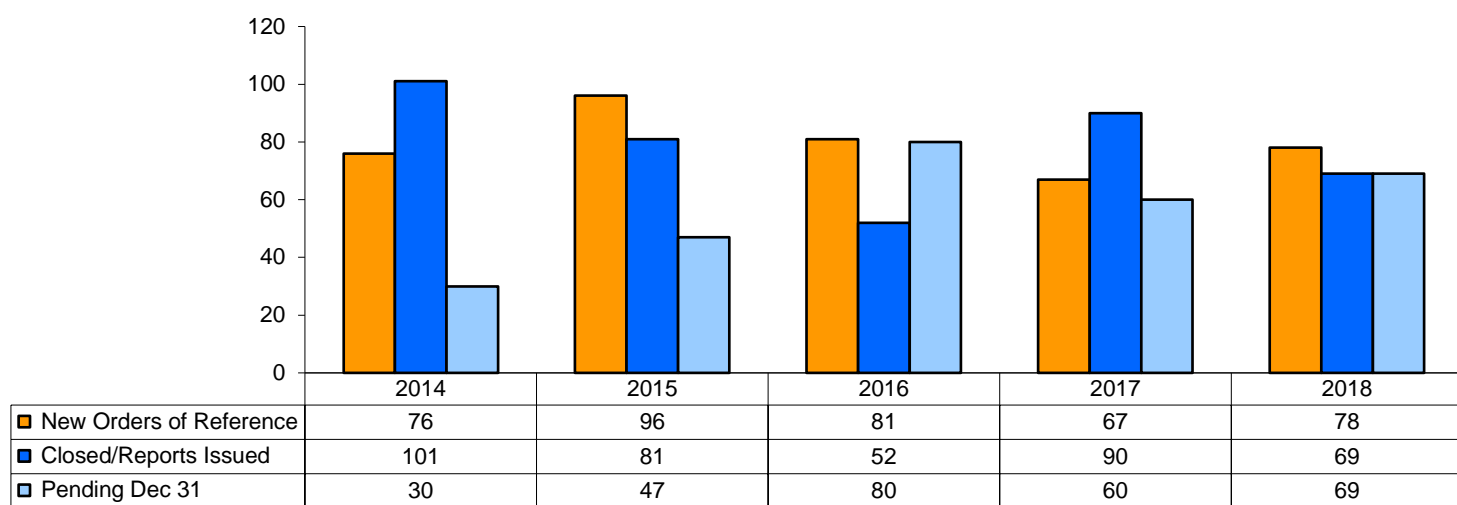

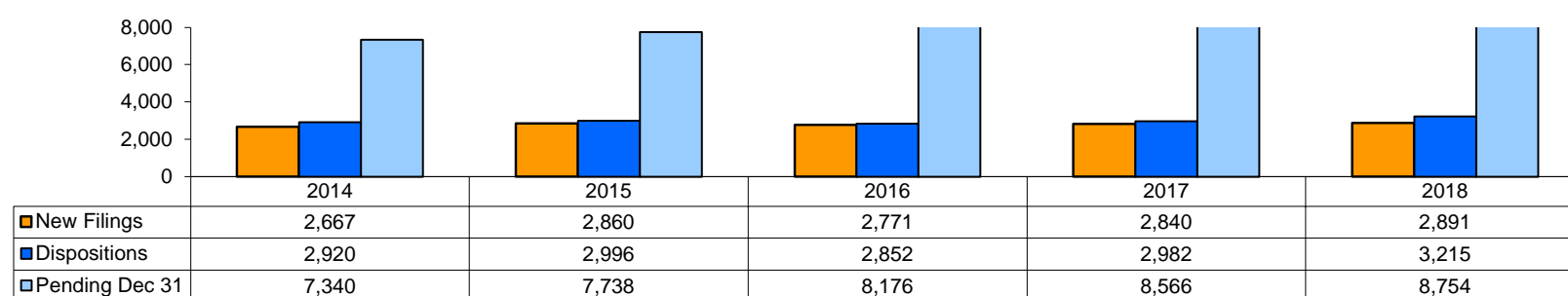

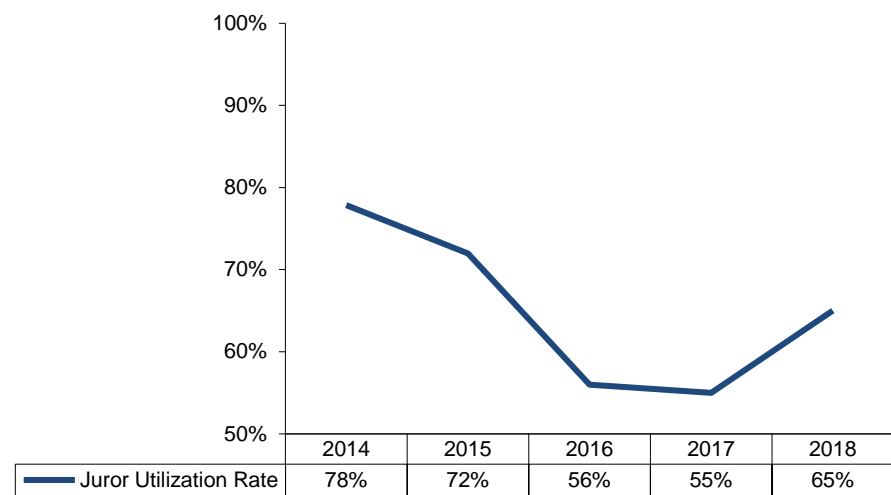

#### Tax Case Activity, CY 2014-2018

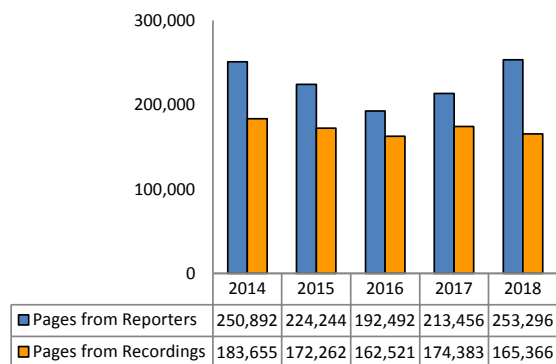

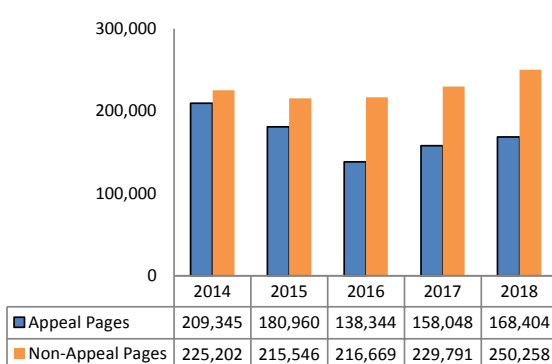
