

**SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 19-10
(Amending Administrative Order 18-14)**

WHEREAS, D.C. Code § 4-505(a) provides that the Chief Judge of the Superior Court shall appoint five members to the Crime Victims Compensation Appeals Board (Appeals Board) from among the membership of the Crime Victims Compensation Advisory Commission (Commission); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to D.C. Code § 4-505(a), Appeals Board members shall serve at the Chief Judge's pleasure, reflect a variety of disciplines, and include at least one attorney; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to D.C. Code § 4-505(a), the Chief Judge may appoint qualified members of the Commission to serve as alternates on the Appeals Board when Board members are not available; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 18-14 first established the Appeals Board and it is in the best interest of the administration of justice that vacancies on the Appeals Board be filled in a timely manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is, by the Court,

ORDERED, that the following person be hereby removed from to the Appeals Board in the following capacities:

Ana Plaza-Troconis, Ayuda victim service provider, Alternate


ORDERED, that the following person be hereby appointed to the Appeals Board in the following capacities:
