

ORDER

By letter dated July 12, 2023, Chief Judge Anita M. Josey-Herring of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia asked this court to approve proposed amendments to Superior Court Rule of Civil Procedure 16 and Rules of Criminal Procedure 28, 49.1, and 55. To the extent that those amendments modify the Federal Rules of Civil and Criminal Procedure, it is hereby

ORDERED, pursuant to D.C. Code § 11-946, that the proposed amendments are approved.

By the same letter, Chief Judge Josey-Herring asked this court to stay the date on which the 2023 amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil and Criminal Procedure would otherwise automatically take effect in Superior Court. Upon consideration of that request, it is hereby

ORDERED that the date on which the 2023 amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil and Criminal Procedure would otherwise go into effect in the Superior Court is stayed until December 31, 2024.
