ORDER

On consideration of the order from the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board suspending respondent by consent from the practice of law in Virginia for six months; this court's July 3, 2025, order suspending respondent in the District pending this matter's resolution and directing her to show cause why identical reciprocal discipline should not be imposed; the response thereto in which respondent consents to the imposition of reciprocal discipline nunc pro tunc to the filing of her D.C. Bar R. XI, § 14(g) affidavit; the statement of Disciplinary Counsel recommending that identical reciprocal discipline be imposed; and respondent's D.C. Bar R. XI, § 14(g) affidavit, filed July 4, 2025; it is

ORDERED that Rebecca Roby is hereby suspended from the practice of law in the District of Columbia for six months, nunc pro tunc to July 4, 2025. *See In re Sibley*, 990 A.2d 483, 487-88 (D.C. 2010) (explaining that exceptions to the rebuttable presumption in favor of identical reciprocal discipline should be rare).
