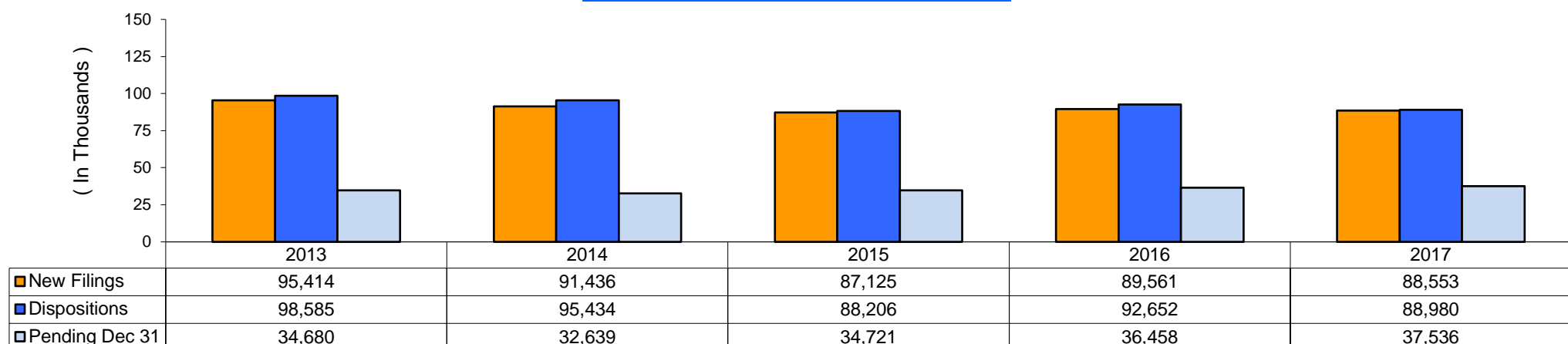

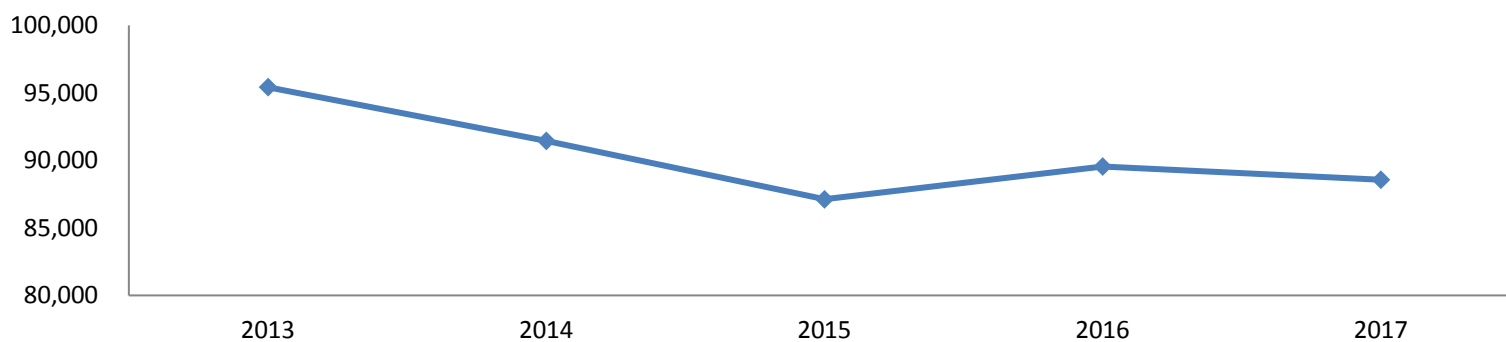

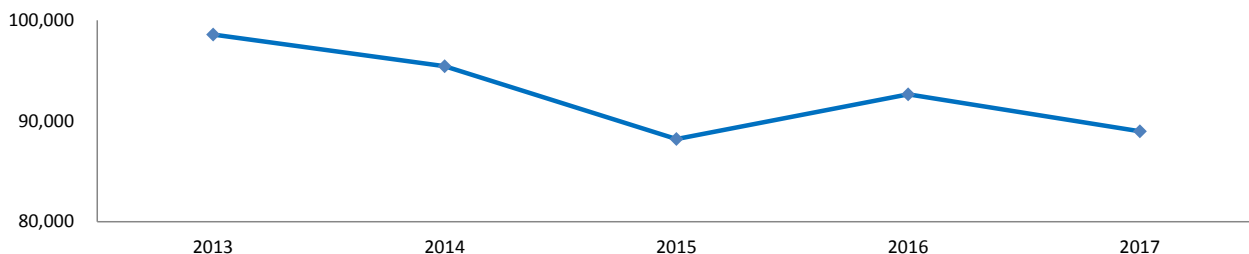
NEW CASE FILINGS TREND

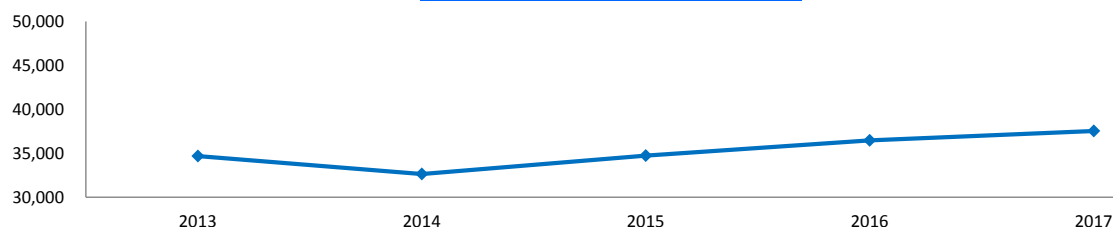

PENDING CASELOAD TREND



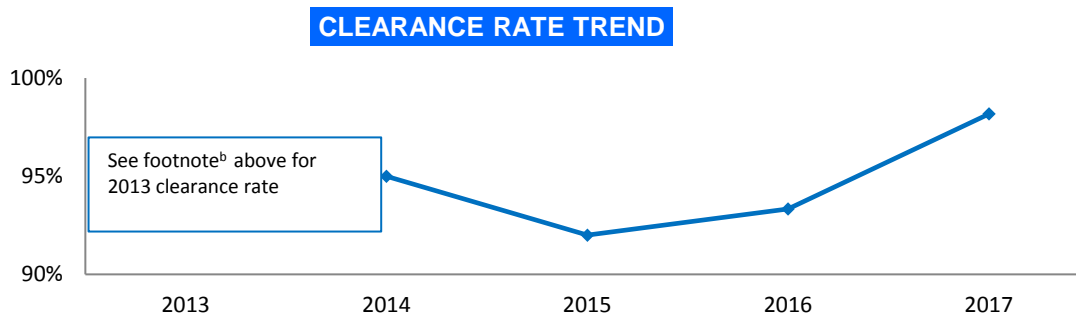

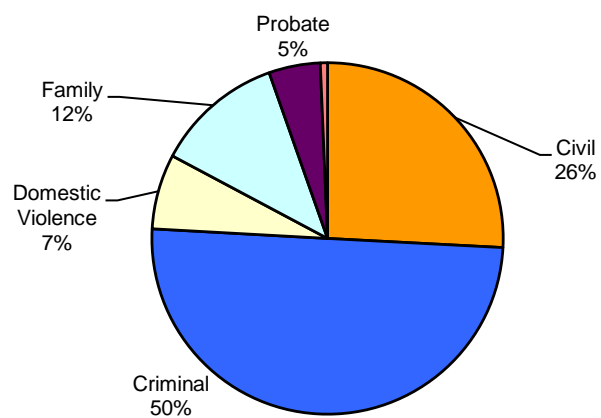

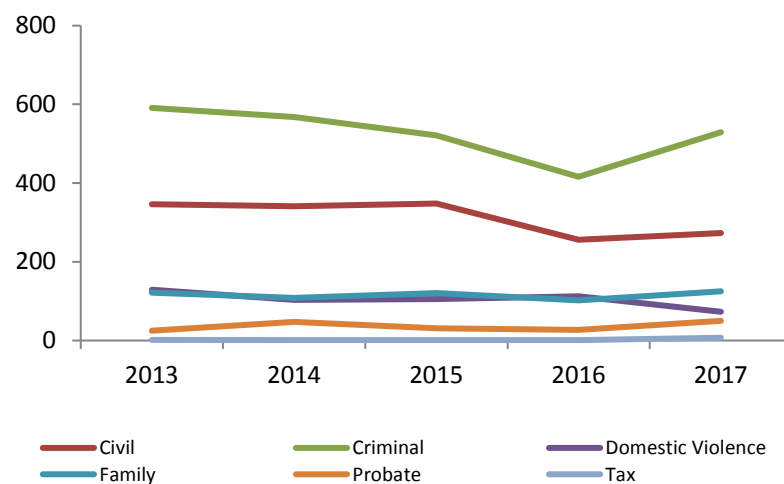

Trend in Appeals, CY2013-2017

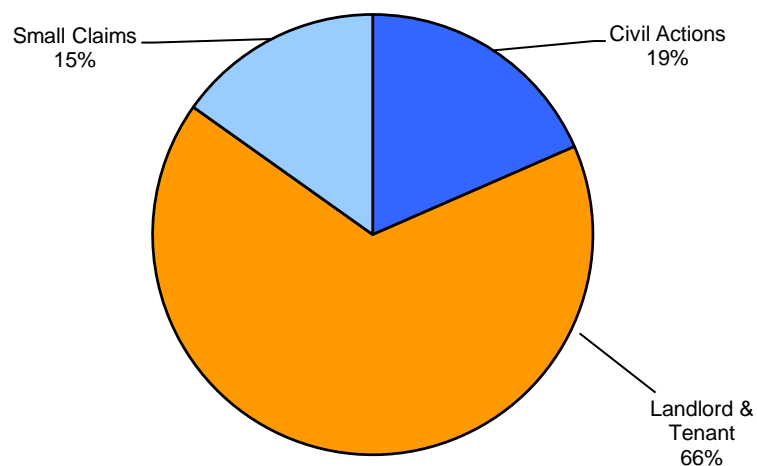

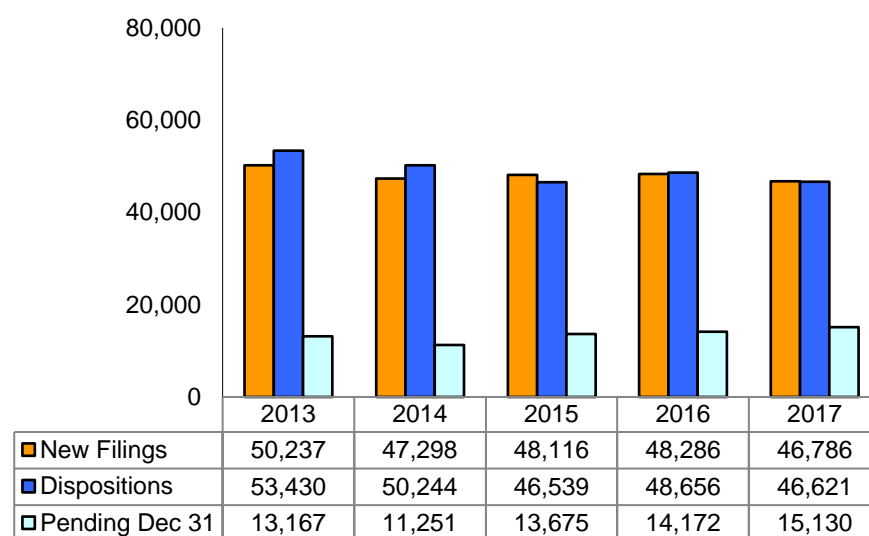

2017 New Case Filings (N=46,786)



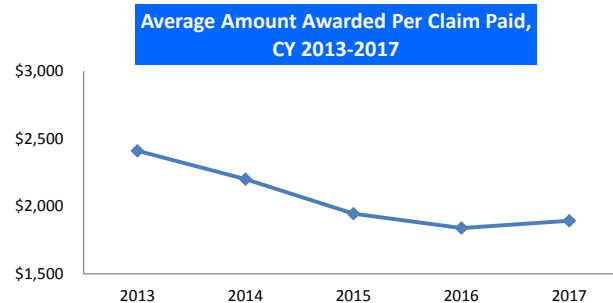
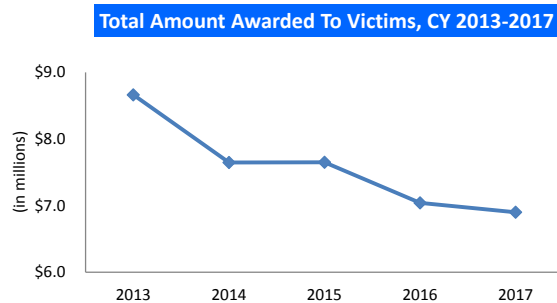
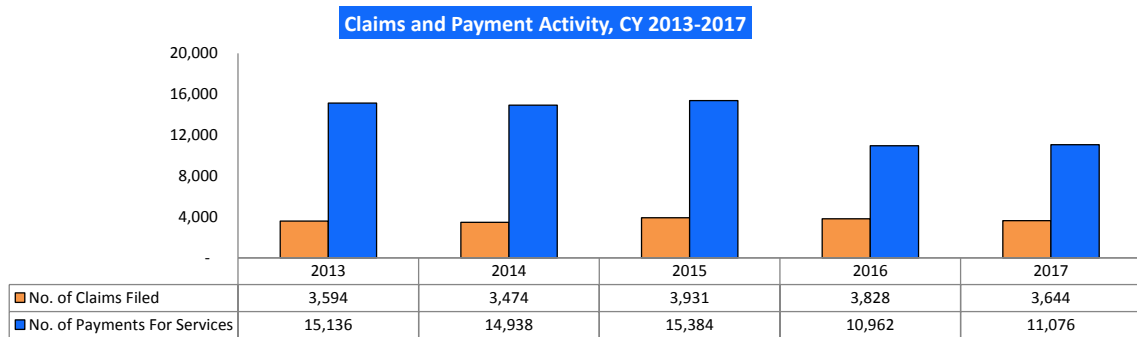

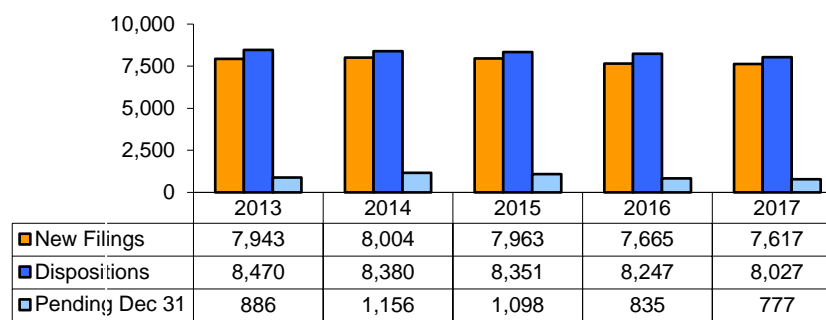

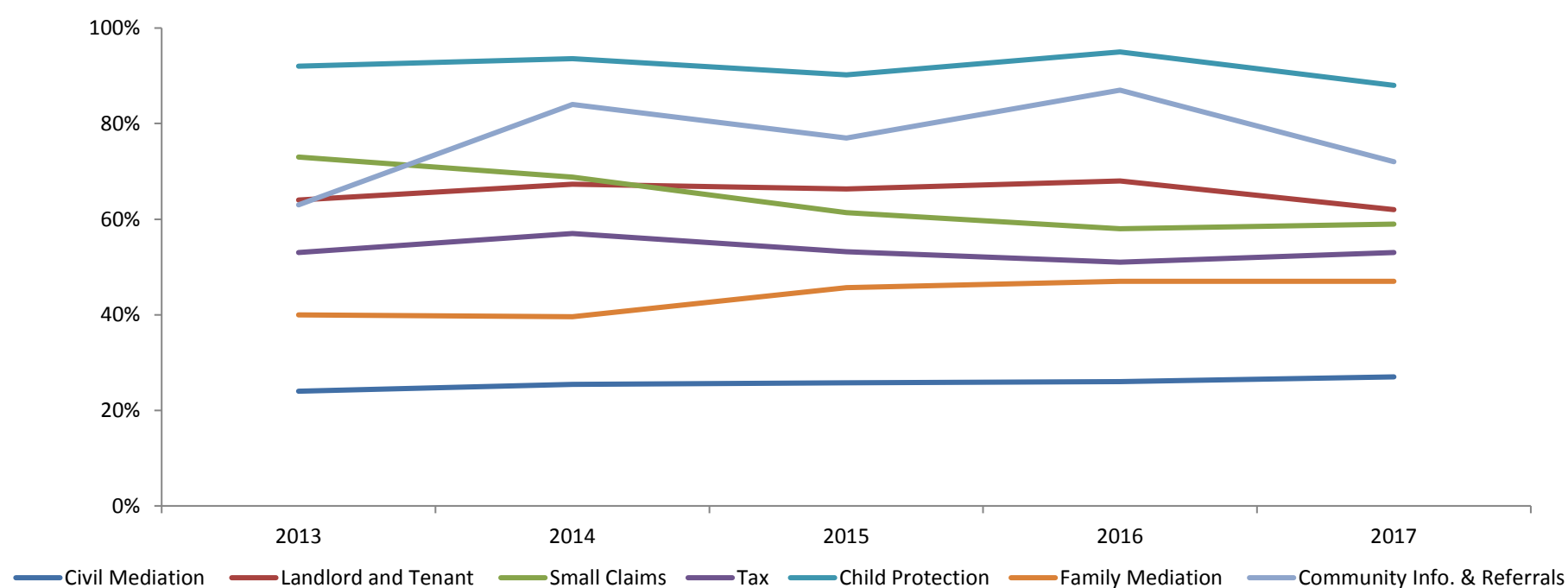

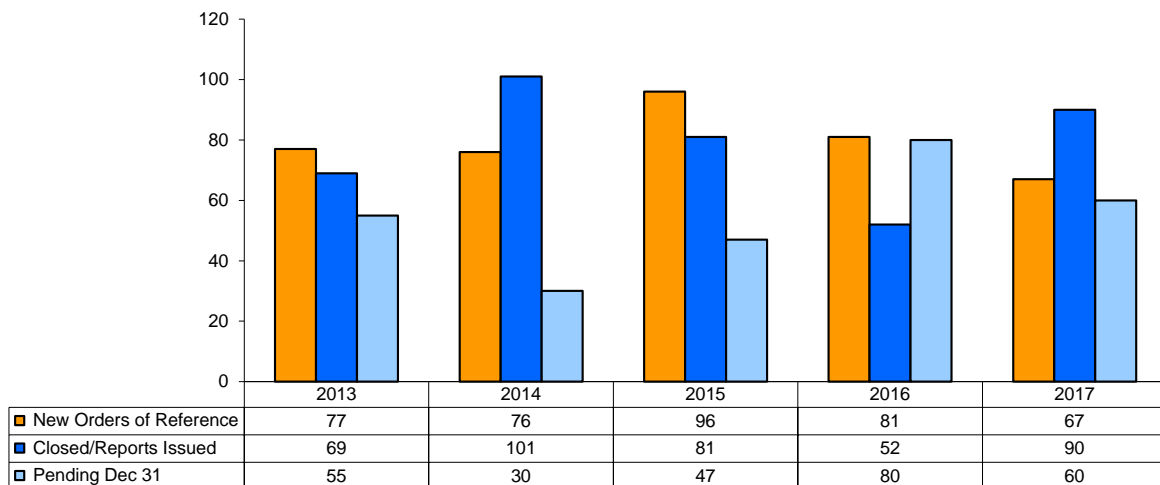

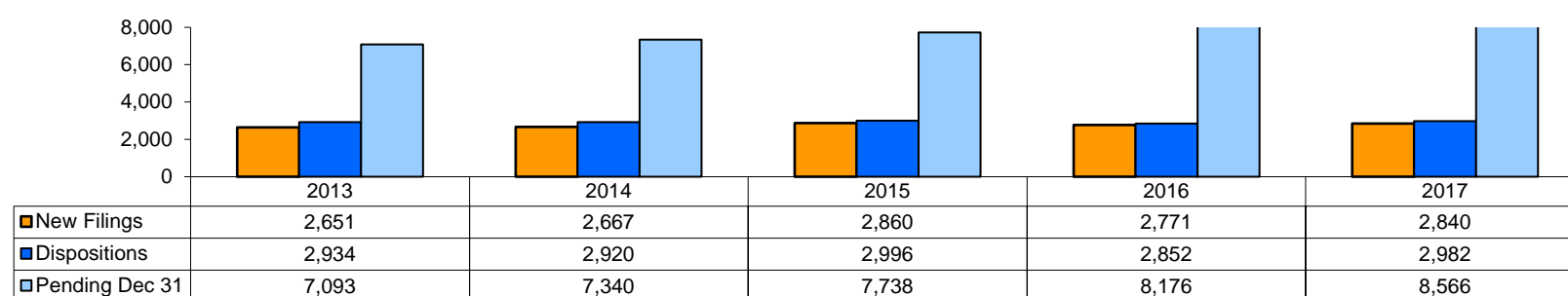

Probate Case Activity, CY 2013-2017



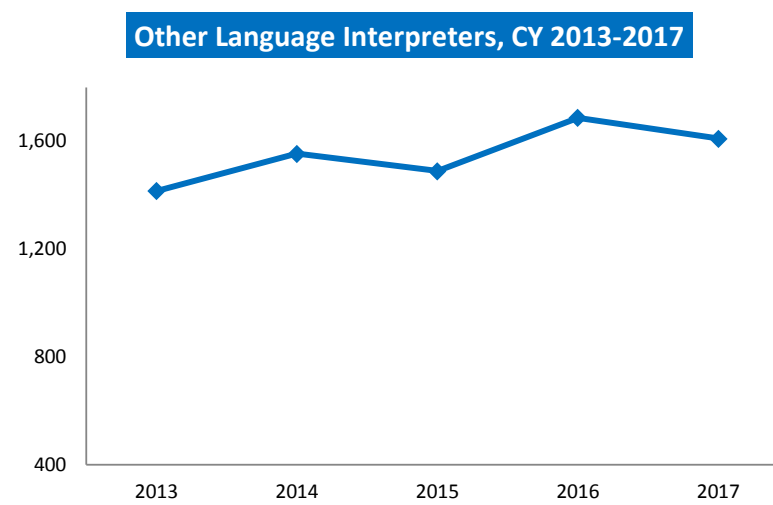
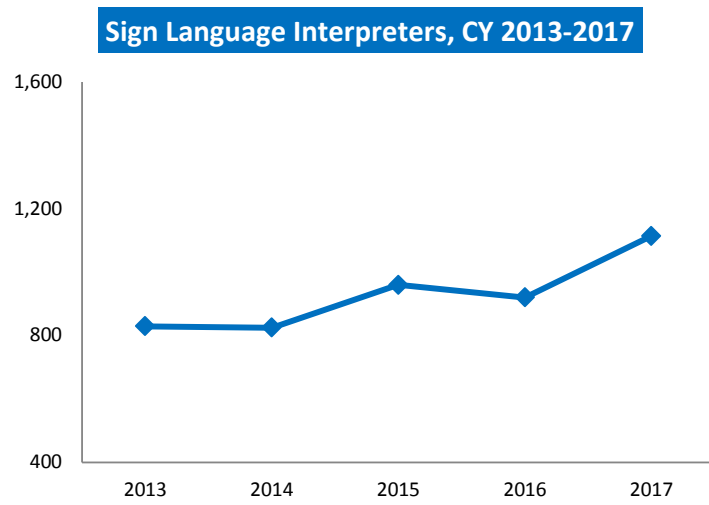
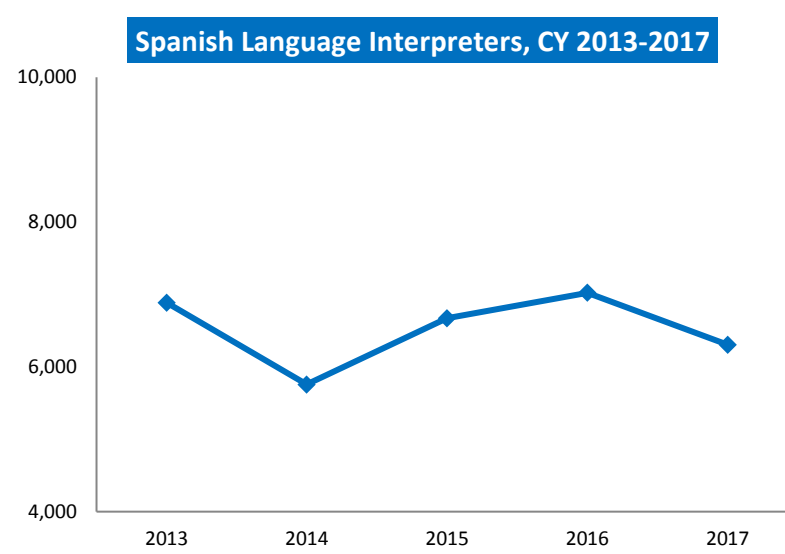
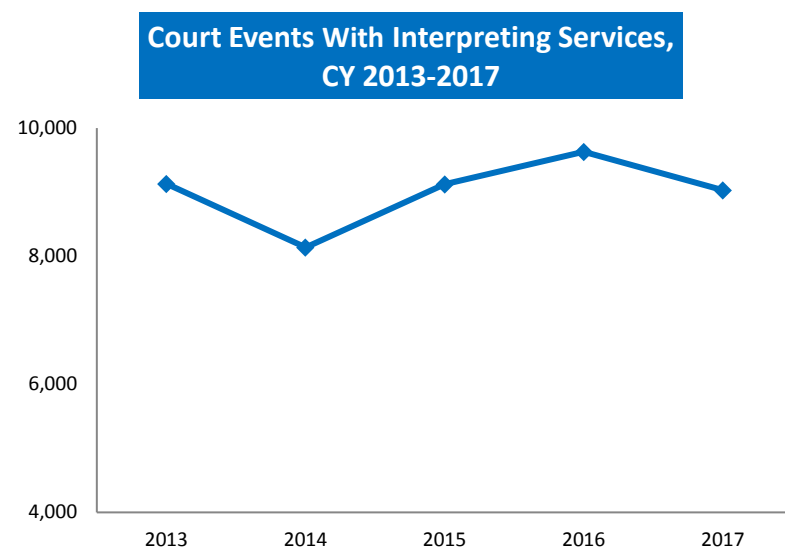

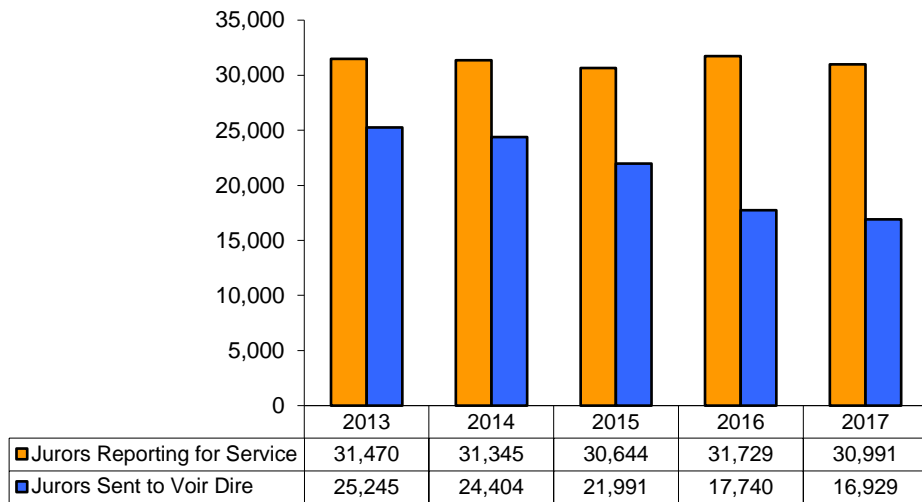

Petit Juror Utilization, CY 2013-2017

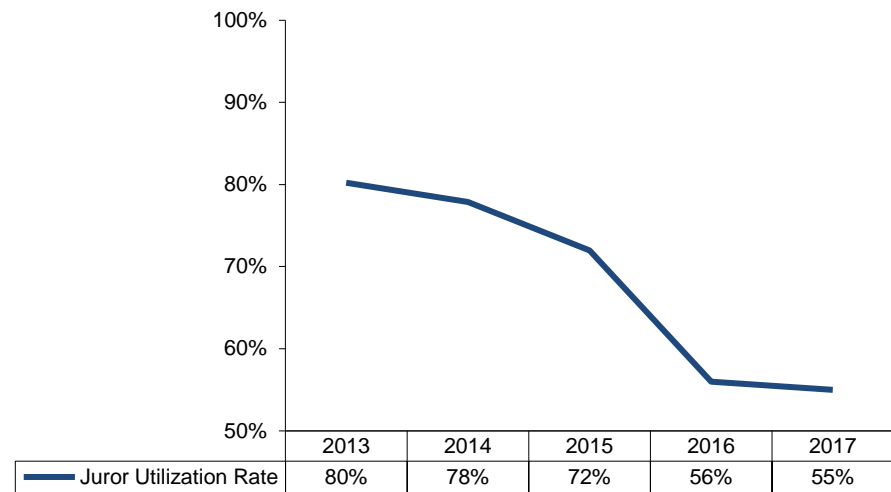

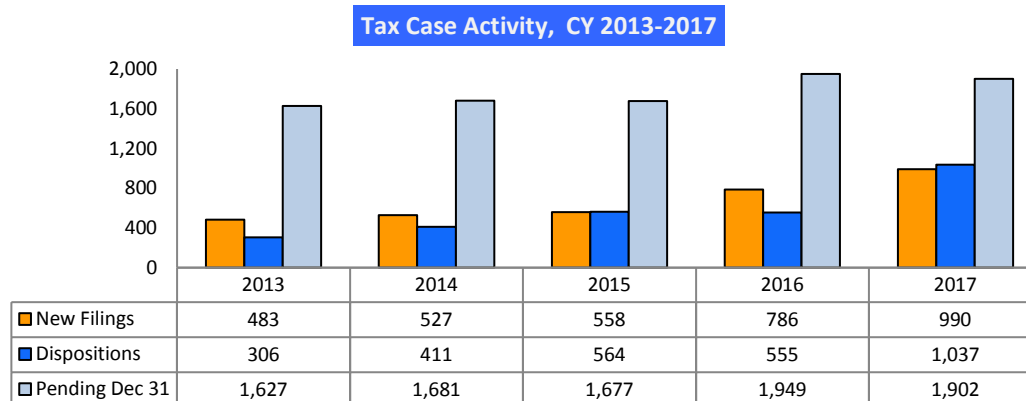
