Clerkships

Judge McLeese is not currently considering applications for clerkships. Future clerkship openings will be advertised on this site with information regarding how to apply.

Internships

Judge McLeese is currently accepting applications from first-year and second-year law students for an unpaid judicial internship in the spring of 2021, and for an unpaid judicial internship in the summer of 2021. Applications will be considered on a rolling basis.

Given the ongoing health crisis, candidates should assume that internships for the spring and summer of 2021 will be fulfilled remotely, with the possibility that changing circumstances may allow for in-person work. Should in-person work become possible, interns will have the option to work in-person, but will not be required to do so.

Applicants should submit a cover letter, a resume, an official or unofficial law-school transcript, and a writing sample. Applicants who submit applications before receiving fall-semester grades should update their applications when grades become available by sending a transcript and any other pertinent information.
