HOW DO I CHANGE MY METHOD OF APPEARANCE?

- You must submit an Application to Appear In Person within 24 hours of receiving the notice of your scheduled meditation.
- The Application can be submitted electronically, or sent by email to: <u>CivilIn-PersonRequest@dcsc.gov</u> (for Civil Mediations) and <u>FamilyIn-PersonRequest@dcsc.gov</u> (for Family Mediations).
- Once the application is received, the assigned Case Manager will respond to the requesting participant(s) within one business day.

If you appear in-person for a remote mediation, you can participate at the courthouse.
