Sol Glasner served for more than two decades as a corporate general counsel and senior business executive. In this role, he demonstrated leadership in corporate and board governance, compliance, strategic business planning and a range of substantive issues at the crossroads of law and business. He also serves as a public arbitrator for the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA).
