

**General Information In Considering Whether You Need Test Accommodations For A Disability on a Remote Bar Examination in the District of Columbia**

The remotely-administered February 2021 bar exam will be composed of all components of the Uniform Bar Examination (UBE), that is, two Multistate Performance Test (MPT) items, six Multistate Essay Examination (MEE) questions and 200 Multistate Bar Examination (MBE) questions.

When considering whether you may need a test accommodation for a disability on a remote exam, keep in mind that all applicants will be able to:

- ✓ Take the UBE in a location of their choice with their own computer using secure software.
- ✓ Increase the font size of both the question and answer text for all test sessions.
- ✓ Use scrap paper for the MPT items.
- ✓ Use spell check in response to the MPT items and MEE questions.
- ✓ Directly select MBE answer choices on the computer screen (as well as strike out answer choices). **There is no scantron sheet with circles to darken.**

When considering whether you may need a test accommodation for a disability on a remote exam, keep in mind the remote schedule for standard time applicants and the remote schedule for applicants granted accommodations for a disability:

1. The remote schedule for standard time applicants includes eight (8), 90-minute testing sessions over two days with scheduled breaks between test sessions and a lunch break.

<b>Remote Schedule for Standard Time Applicants</b>	
<i>The precise start time of each session has not yet been announced. Breaks between sessions are 30 minutes. The lunch break is 90 minutes.</i>

- The remote schedule for applicants granted test accommodations for a disability includes sixteen (16) testing sessions of varying times over four days with scheduled breaks between each test session.

<i>The precise start time of each session will be outlined in each applicant's determination letter. All breaks between sessions are at least 30 minutes.</i>

- The schedule format is designed to facilitate video monitoring throughout the exam. Video monitoring replaces live proctoring which is conducted at an in person exam.
- The above schedule represents the order of test session on each day (the specific times of each session will be outlined in the applicant's determination letter).
- Additional testing time awarded (25%, 50%, 100%) will be added to the above times.
- All schedules will start at the same time each day (but will end at different times depending on the amount of extra testing time that is awarded).
