

Request Verification of Reciprocity

1. Some jurisdictions require bar applicants to provide a Verification of Reciprocity form to document bar admission in the District of Columbia. (If you need a Certificate of Good Standing, [click here](#). If you need a certificate concerning discipline, [click here](#).)

2. The following documents are required to request a Verification of Reciprocity form from the District of Columbia Court of Appeals:
 - a. Your jurisdiction's Verification of Reciprocity form—include your name and D.C. Bar number on the form;
 - b. \$10 check or money order, payable to Clerk, D.C. Court of Appeals;
 - c. Self-addressed, stamped envelope (for urgent requests, please send your return envelope using U.S. Priority or Express Mail only).
 - d. Do not send a Fed Ex nor a UPS return envelope.

3. Mail or deliver the documents to--
