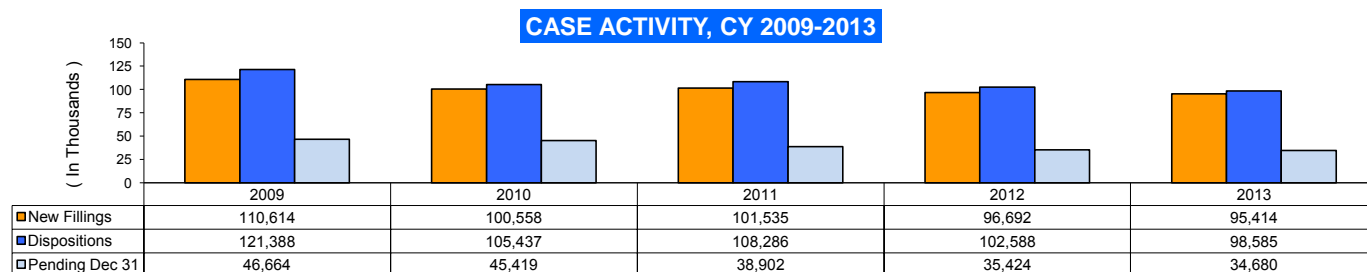

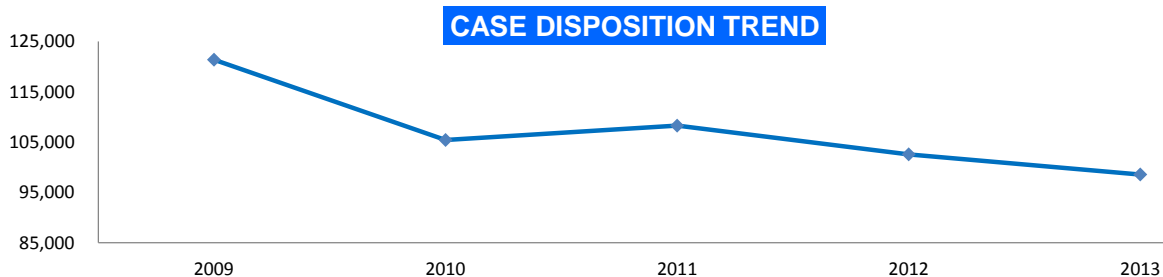

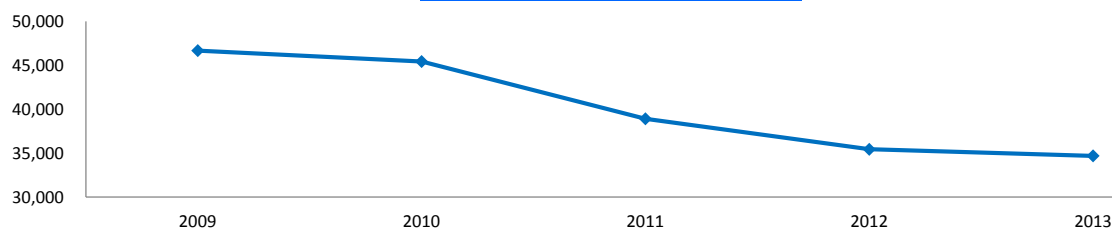

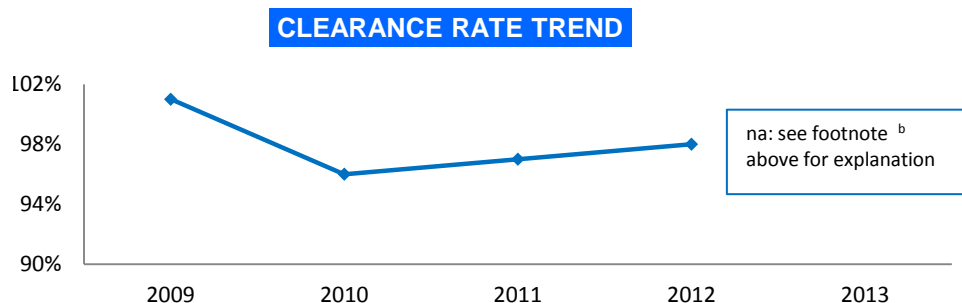

2013 Appeals By Case Type (N=1,214)



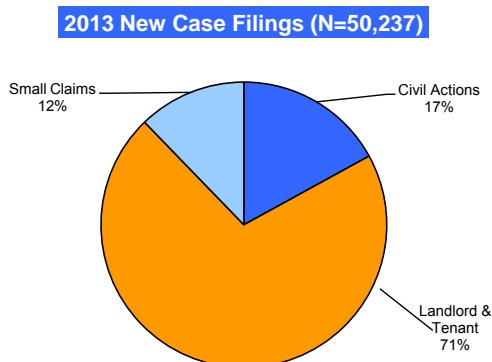
Trend in Appeals, CY 2009-2013



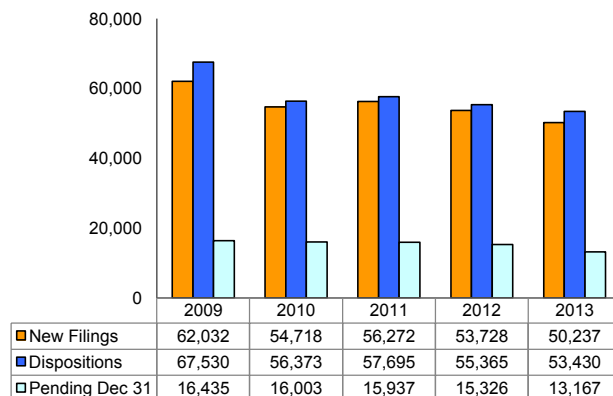

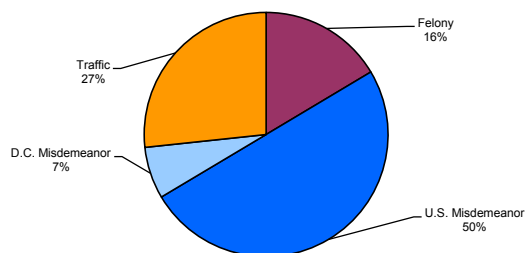

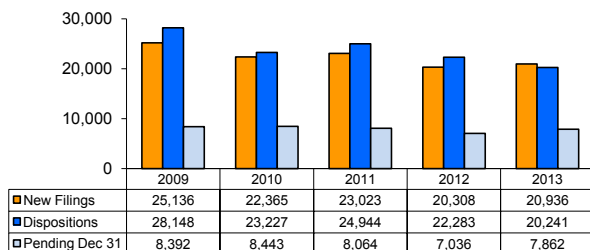

Criminal Case Activity, CY 2009-2013



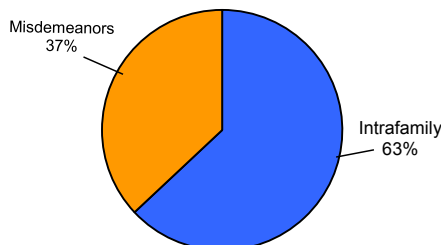

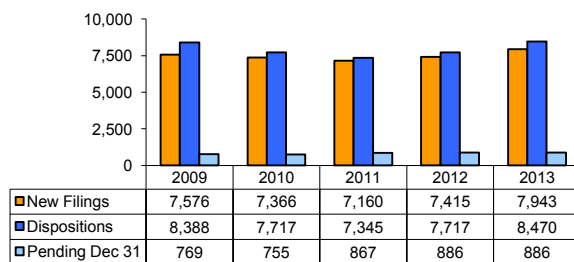

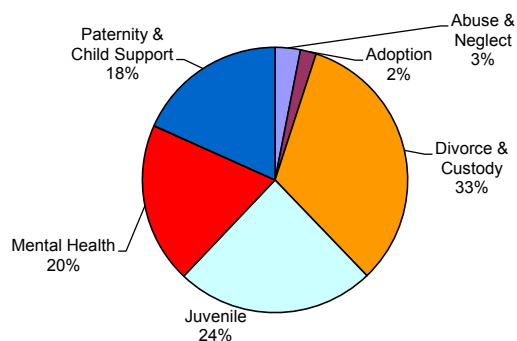

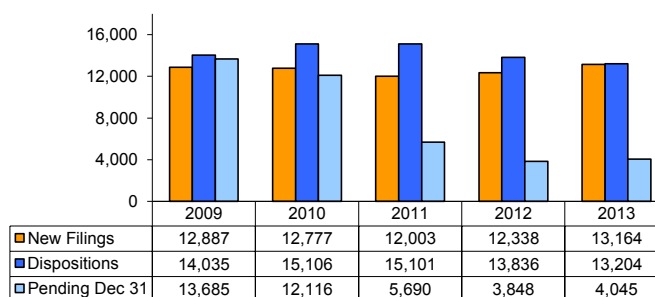

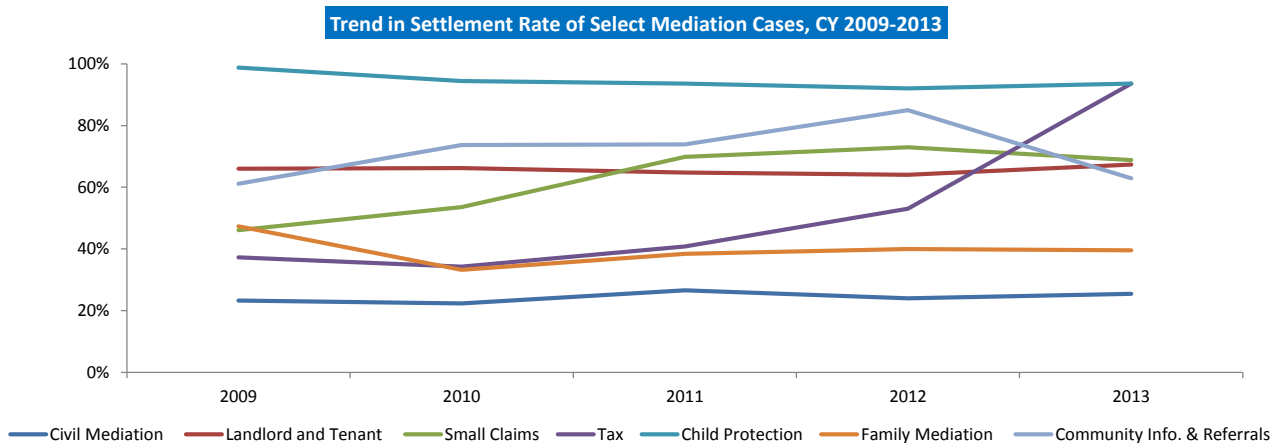

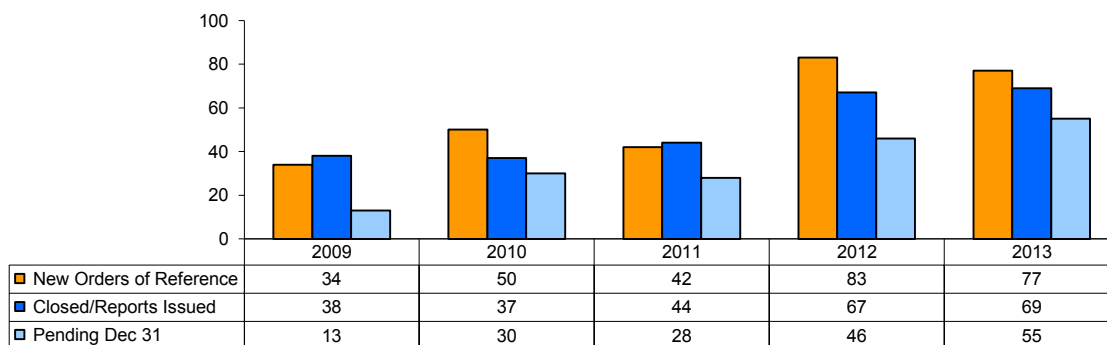

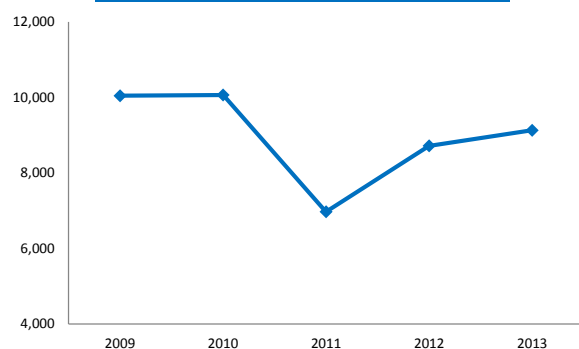

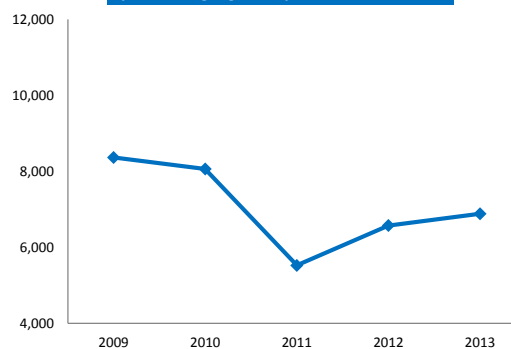

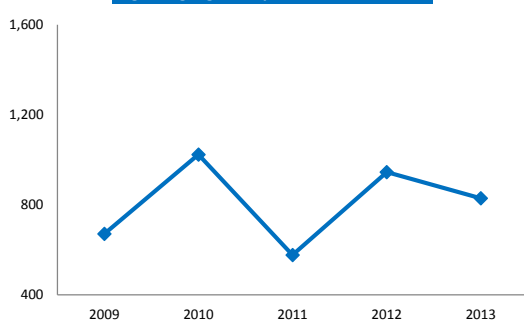
Court Events With Interpreting Services, CY 2009-2013



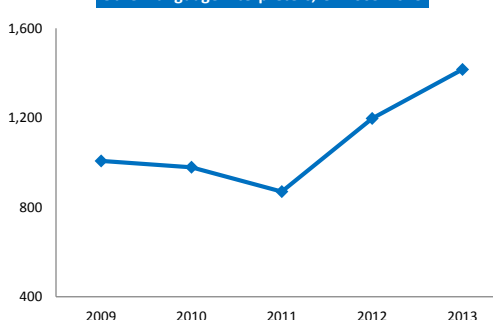
Spanish Language Interpreters, CY 2009-2013

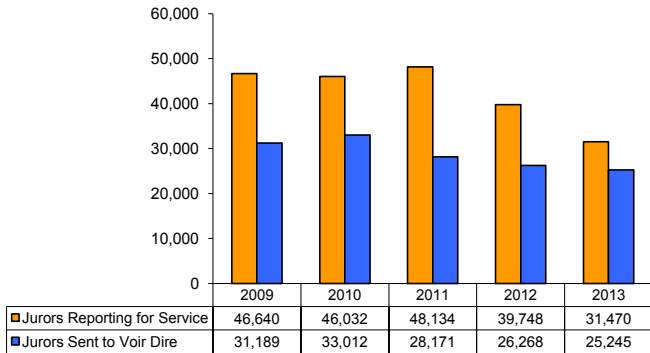

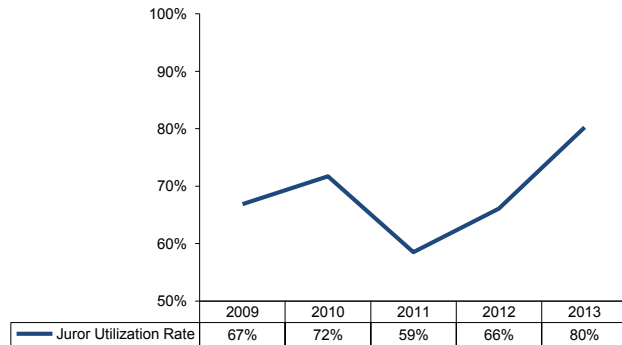

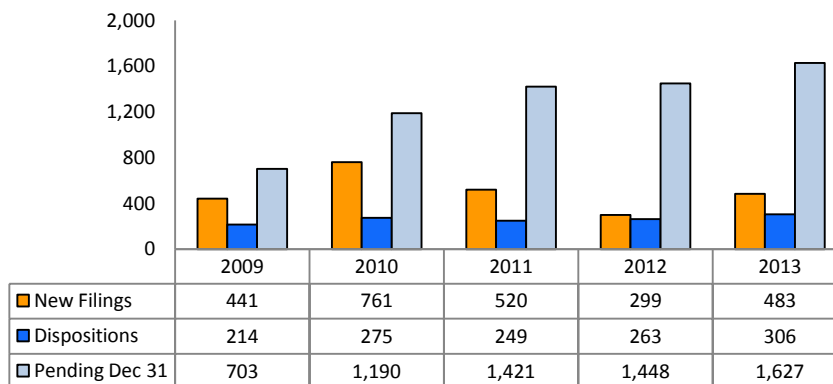

Tax Case Activity, CY 2009-2013

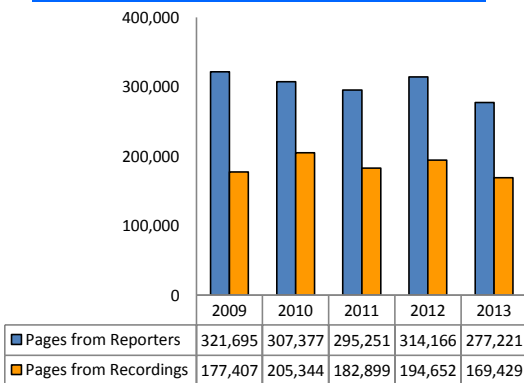
