

SOLICITATION QUESTIONS & ANSWERS: ROUND 02

- 1) I noticed that the signage has to be specified as 2/90 or Gerber, but please confirm the signage will be bid as part of this package for manufacturing. If the signage will not be bid, please provide contract number for which 2/90 and Gerber were identified as a best value for this project.

R: Please refer to Amendment No. 0001 issued November 20, 2018, questions 9 and 10.

- 2) The Formula you are asking for estimated time and labor reports for the bid. Does not take into account equipment- weather rental of equipment and delay caused by traffic or labor for unknown items. How do you want us to guess on the estimated labor time of what we do not know when we go to wire a sign ? I can estimate a 3 person x 40 hrs x 108 per hour but we might be longer or shorter. The lump sum price also reflects our risk on time. Therefore we can submit a lump sum price better then a hourly rate price or do you want the hourly rate price?.

R: The contract to be awarded will be a Hybrid Contract:

- A) Fix Price component for management of the service: Tasks C.4.1, C.4.2, C.4.5 and C.4.6.
- B) Cost Reimbursable Component for the production and installation of the signs: Task C4.3 and C4.5. All the task associated with installing the signs will be reimbursed at cost.
